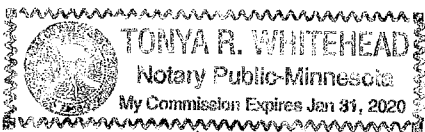

Sealed proposals for the work described below will be received by the City Engineer at the 2860 Civic Center Dr., Roseville, MN 55113-1815 until August 22, 2017 at 11:00 a.m. C.D.S.T. at which time the bids will be opened and publicly read, for the furnishing of all labor, materials, and all else necessary for the following:

**DESCRIPTION OF WORK:  
Roseville Booster Station  
Improvements, City Project 17-19**

In general, the work includes the following:  
A. Removal of select process piping, valves, fittings, and concrete curbing inside of the booster station, Removal of the existing diesel generator, electrical equipment and

appurtenances inside of the booster station.  
B. Removal of a portion of the exterior buried process piping adjacent to the Booster Station and replacement with new piping, fittings, valves.  
C. Removal of the existing exterior excel energy electrical equipment and installation of a new 600KW diesel generator, transfer switch, pad mount transformer on an exterior concrete pad.  
D. Installation of a new main service entrance switchgear inside of the Booster Station on the south side of the building.

**COMPLETION OF WORK:** All work under the Contract must be Substantially complete by Feb 1, 2018, and achieve Final completion by March 1, 2018.

**BEST VALUE CONTRACTING:** The City believes that only a contractor with good experience in constructing this kind of project is necessary. Two factors will be considered in

the contractor selection process: price and performance. The process for consideration of proposals for the award of the Project will take into account not only the Contract amount proposed for construction items, but also the proposer's ability and performance on previous similar projects, within or outside the City of Roseville, and the proposer's availability of major equipment to perform this project. The evaluation criteria to be utilized will be the total proposal price divided by the aggregate average technical performance score, as determined by the technical evaluation committee and fully set forth in the Proposing Requirements Documents. The required documentation must be submitted to the City of Roseville

by August 18, 2017 at 12:00 p.m. C.D.S.T.

**MINIMUM CONTRACTOR**

**QUALIFICATIONS:** The Bidder shall have experience as a General Contractor in the successful completion of at least three (3) Booster Stations and/or Water Treatment Facilities within the last five (5) years.

Bidders are required to attend the pre-bid conference.

**BID SECURITY:** A certified check or a Bid Bond satisfactory to the City of Roseville, Minnesota, in the amount of not less than 10 percent of the total Bid price submitted must accompany each Bid.

**LABOR RATES - MINIMUM WAGE REQUIREMENTS:**

This project is being funded by the City of Roseville, MN. The project is not subject to the provisions of Little Davis-Bacon Act.

**PERFORMANCE AND PAYMENT BONDS:**

The successful Bidder will be required to furnish a Performance Bond and Labor and Materials Payment Bond each in the amount of the Contract. The Bid, Agreement, and Bonds shall be conditioned upon compliance with all provisions of the Bid Documents.
