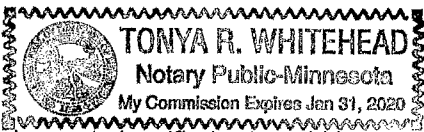

Notice is hereby given that sealed Proposals will be received by the City of Roseville until 11:00 a.m., Tuesday, October, 3, 2017, at the Office of the City Engineer, 2660 Civic Center Drive, Roseville, at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud, for the furnishing of all labor and material for the construction of Walsh Storm Sewer Lift Station. The Walsh storm sewer lift station project includes general demolition and salvage of equipment in existing stormwater lift station and intake structure; new stormwater pump, controls, intake structure, valve vault, and appurtenances; and general site improvements.

Proposals shall be on the form provided for that purpose and according to the Proposing Requirements prepared by Short Elliott Hendrickson Inc. (SEH®) dated September 12, 2017.
