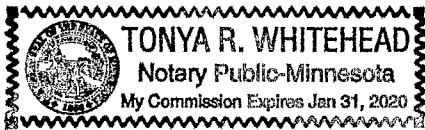

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
TITLE THREE CHAPTER 304
TO AMEND REQUIREMENTS
WHERE LAWFUL GAMBLING
PROCEEDS ARE EXPENDED
THE CITY OF ROSEVILLE
ORDAINS:**

SECTION 1: Title Three, Chapter 304 of the Roseville City Code is amended to read as follows:

304.04: CONTRIBUTIONS

C. Excluding amounts contributed to the Roseville Community Fund, 90% of the remaining net profits shall be expended in the City's trade area as defined in Mn Statutes 349.213, subd. 1(g). Roseville's trade area includes: Roseville, Arden Hills, Falcon Heights, Lauderdale, Little Canada, Maplewood, Minneapolis, New Brighton, St. Anthony, St. Paul, and Shoreview.
